

## ENDINGS & BEGINNINGS

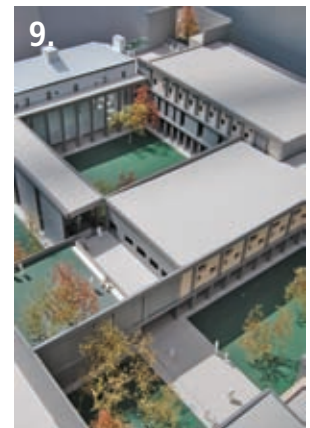
### UNIVERSITY OF ULSTER
